SAMPLE ITINERARY

DAY 1: ARRIVAL

Upon arrival, you will be met at baggage claim, helped with luggage, brought to your waiting luxury transportation and whisked to your hotel. Check into the sumptuous Winvian Farm resort in the Litchfield Hills of Connecticut for a two-night stay.

DAY 2: MORRIS, CT

Start your New England experience on the water! Paddle through the winding bends of the Bantam River in canoes or kayaks, and glide past ornate beaver lodges and blue herons on your way to Bantam Lake. Since no prior experience is required, guests of all ages can escape civilization for a while. Ready for a different view? Saddle up and go horseback riding through hills and valleys on a private riding experience. Choose from either a trail ride or learn a bit of control through an instructor guided lesson.

DAY 3: ARRIVAL IN LENOX, MA

Next stop—the Berkshires! A rural region in the mountains of western Massachusetts dotted with villages and towns, it is known for outdoor activities, fall foliage viewing and thriving arts institutions. Your home for the next two nights is the elegant Wheatleigh Hotel in Lenox. Enjoy dinner at your resort.

DAY 4: HIGHLIGHTS OF WESTERN MASSACHUSETTS

Spend a full day exploring the highlights of Western Massachusetts. Then, experience the Gilded Age in person at Ventfort Hall, an imposing Jacobean Revival-style mansion built in 1893 for Sarah

Morgan, the sister of J. P. Morgan. One of the approximately seventy-five so-called “Cottages” built in Lenox in the late 19th century when the village became a popular Gilded Age resort, Ventfort Hall is located on spacious grounds in the heart of the village. The Museum of the Gilded Age interprets the great changes that occurred in American life, industry, and society during the Nineteenth Century.

No visit to the Berkshires would be complete without a visit to the Norman Rockwell Museum, dedicated to one of the best known and most beloved artists to hail from New England. The Museum houses the world’s largest and most significant collection of Rockwell art and is a world resource for reflection, involvement and discovery inspired by Norman Rockwell. There is a vibrant farm to table restaurant scene in Lenox, be sure to check it out.

Overnight at Wheatleigh Hotel

DAY 5: MASS MOCA AND ARRIVAL IN WARREN, VT

After checking out of your hotel, make your way to Warren, Vermont. En route, visit Mass MoCA (the Massachusetts Museum of Contemporary Art) where you will meet your guide and engage in a private tour of Building 6. MASS MoCA is one of the largest centers for contemporary visual art and performing arts in the United States. Building 6 is just one of the buildings on the campus but at three stories tall with each floor measuring an acre of space, the building offers half of the total exhibition space of the space of the campus. Your guide will provide an engaging tour to promote an interactive experience as you view and contemplate the masterpieces selected to be housed in Building 6. Your hour-long tour will be tailored to your interests and provide a highlight of the collection.

In the afternoon, arrive at the charming The Pitcher Inn. Use the hotel as a base to see Vermont.

DAY 6: CHARMING VERMONT

In the morning, kayak, stand-up paddle (available through September) or simply visit beautiful Lake Champlain, the nation’s sixth largest natural freshwater lake. Make your way across the water and around the Lake Champlain Islands.

Visit the quaint, picturesque towns of Stowe, Woodstock or Weston. Wander arts and crafts fairs, museums and galleries or attend musical and theatrical performances in Stowe, sample maple syrups and cheeses at Sugarbush Farm in Woodstock or visit quintessential country stores in Weston.
